Middlesex Cricket Board's 2011/12 Coach Education programme consists of the following courses:

- 2 x Candidate Pre-Course Preparation Days
- 6 x UKCC1 Coaching Assistant courses
- 5 x UKCC2 Coach Award courses
- 1 x set of Coach Development Workshops (leading to Club Coach Assessment)
- 2 x Chance to Shine Coach Development Days
- 1 x Working in Schools Modules
- 2 x Disability Awareness Workshops
- 1 x Cricket for Teachers Modules

### **How to Apply**

Applications must be supported by a relevant organisation and are welcomed from the following:

- MCB Focus Clubs with Clubmark Status
- MCB Affiliated Clubs
- Schools within Middlesex
- Delivery Partners working with Middlesex Cricket
- Organisations wishing to deliver cricket as per the MCB Strategic Plan

Applications will all be considered and places allocated in line with the MCB Strategic and Workforce Development Plans.

### **Application Process**

Deadlines for Applications:

**Applications for Pre-Christmas Courses must be received by 9th September 2011**

**Applications for New Year courses must be received by 9th December 2011**

Any applications not received by these dates will only be considered should places remain available after allocation has been done and acceptance on the chosen course can not be guaranteed.

### **Candidate Pre-Course Preparation Days**

Candidates who have no previous cricket coaching qualification **MUST** attend one of the Pre-Course Preparation Days.

These days will cover the following:

- Pre-course practical and theory sessions to help prepare candidates
- Determination of relevant starting course for coaches; UKCC1 or UKCC2
- First Aid Course (mandatory requirement for qualification)
- ECB Criminal Records Bureau (CRB) Check completion (mandatory requirement for qualification)

### **Confirmation of Places**

The candidate and club representative who made the application will be informed of place allocation approximately two weeks after each application deadline.

Clubs will be invoiced for course places and payment will be deemed as acceptance of the place on the course.

### MIDDLESEX CRICKET BOARD WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PLAN—VISION

*In order to ensure that these support structures are fully sustainable it is a priority to ensure that the workforce currently in place, and developed in the future, is managed and trained to the highest standard.”*

### CANDIDATE PRE-COURSE PREPARATION DAYS

In order to ensure that the above vision becomes a reality Middlesex Cricket Board are continually reviewing the way they develop the coaching workforce at all levels across the county, this has lead to the introduction of Pre-Course Preparation Days for coaches with no previous ECB Coaching Qualification.

Candidates looking to take their first step on to the coaching pathway MUST attend one of these courses prior to applying to attend a UKCC course as per below:

- 1) NEW COACHES WISHING TO PROGRESS STRAIGHT TO UKCC2 MUST ATTEND THE WHOLE DAY
- 2) NEW COACHES WISHING TO ATTEND A UKCC1 MUST ATTEND HALF THE DAY (FIRST AID & CRB SIGNING)

Each Pre-Course Preparation Day will run over 6 hours and will include the following:

- Pre-course practical and theory sessions to help prepare candidates
- Determination of relevant starting course for coaches; UKCC1 or UKCC2
- First Aid Course (mandatory requirement for qualification)
- ECB Criminal Records Bureau (CRB) Check completion (mandatory requirement for qualification)

The day will not only allow candidates to complete two of the course pre-requisites in First Aid and CRB but will also ensure that all coaches subsequently attend the course best suited to their current skill set.

#### Course Costs:

The cost of the Candidate Pre-Course Preparation Day is incorporated in to that of the UKCC course.

Candidates without a previous ECB coaching qualification will not be able to apply directly to attend a UKCC course without attending all or part of a Candidate Pre-Course Preparation Day.

### UKCC1 COACHING ASSISTANT AWARD

This course is intended for coaches who will be assisting a senior coach and prepares candidates to work with small groups using games and drills to develop technique. The course comprises four 3-hour modules delivered over 2 weekends with the assessment plus multiple-choice test paper on the third weekend.

All candidates must attend a Candidate Pre-Course Preparation Day prior before they can be allocated a place on a UKCC1 Coaching Assistant course

Candidates will also be required to attend a Safeguarding & Protecting Children Module, this will not be part of the course but modules will be run monthly.

Candidates must be a minimum of 16 years of age to apply.

### UKCC2 COACH AWARD

Building on the communication and delivery skills gained at the UKCC1 Level this course gives coaches the necessary skills to plan & run coaching sessions at their clubs and in a school environment.

This course involves four full days of tutoring plus 10 hours supported practice requiring written session planning and evaluation. Assessment takes place after this supported practice has been completed and the session plans & evaluations form part of this assessment process. Please note that the supported practice must be skills based sessions and not net practice.

Candidates must be supported through this process by an already qualified UKCC2 (or higher) coach who will be required to give candidates feedback and countersign all sessions in the logbook provided. Candidates are strongly advised to have plans in place for this prior to applying for a place.

It is highly recommended that candidates consider where they will do their supported practice before they apply, where possible candidates will be offered the opportunity to undertake this on courses run by MCB throughout the County if they cannot do it through their own club.

Unless currently a UKCC1 coach all candidates must attend a Candidate Pre-Course Preparation Day prior before they can be allocated a place on a UKCC2 Coach course

Candidates must be a minimum of 18 years of age to apply.
